

① Mt. Tempaizan (天拝山)
 Sugawara no Michizane pleaded his innocence at the top of this mountain. You can overlook Chikushino City, Dazaifu Government Office remains, and Hakata Bay from the summit.

② Mt. Tempaizan History and Nature Park (天拝山歴史自然公園)
 You can enjoy the beauty of nature in all four seasons. In the park, there is "Ajisai garden" which more than 700 hydrangeas are planted.



③ Buzoji Temple (武蔵寺)
 This temple is the oldest temple at the foot of Mount Tempaizan in Kyushu. There is a wisteria tree named "Chojo no Fuji" in the temple precinct and beautiful wisteria flowers bloom every year.



④ Futsukaichi Hachimangu shrine (二日市八幡宮)
 This shrine was built about 1400 years ago. The big sacred Ginkgo tree in the shrine is believed to ward off evil spirits.



⑤ Chikushino City Historical Museum (筑紫野市歴史博物館)
 Local historic materials from primitive to early modern period are always exhibited. (free of charge)

⑥ Chikushino City Park (筑紫野市総合公園)
 There is playground equipment shaped like the giant ship "Tenpai no Fune" where you can overlook Tenpai Lake. The park is surrounded by nature and a perfect place for an outing. (free of charge)

《Car》 5 minute drive from Chikushino IC or 10 minute drive from Dazaifu IC off Kyushu Expressway.
 《Highway Bus》 30 minutes from Fukuoka Airport to Chikushino Bus Stop "Futsukaichi Onsen Iriguchi."
 《JR Rail》 10 minute walk from Futsukaichi Station.
 《Nishitetsu Rail》 19 minute walk from Nishitetsu Futsukaichi Station. 16 minute walk from Murasaki Station.

⑦ Tatsuwa House of Nature (竜岩自然の家)
 You can enjoy camping, barbecue, swimming in a river, free climbing, and bouldering in the outside facilities surrounded by great nature.




⑧ Remains of Yamae Shuku (山家宿跡)
 Remains of Yamae Shuku are the historical remains of a post town on the Nagasaki Kaido route, which connected Nagasaki and Edo. You can still find remnants of olden times from the entrance gates, the remains of the meeting house for local officers, and a stone engraving of the god Ebisu.



⑨ Chikushi Shrine (筑紫神社)
 This historical shrine became an origin of the name of "Chikushi" City. The legend says that a malignant god found his peace of mind after being enshrined as "Tsukushi no Kami."




⑩ Goroyama Ancient Tomb (五郎山古墳)
 This ancient tomb with great wall paintings was discovered in 1947 and now is in a park. You can see life-size replicas in Goroyama Ancient Tomb Museum.



⑪ Remains of Haruda Shuku (原田宿)
 Haruda Shuku was the post town located at the domain border and in the southernmost point of Chikuzen Mushuku (six post towns) on the Nagasaki Kaido route. There was a checkpoint barrier next to the west entrance gate.



Next Town Dazaifu
Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine (太宰府天満宮)
 The head shrine of all Tenmangu shrines in Japan where Sugawara no Michizane, the God of Study, is enshrined.



Kyushu National Museum (九州国立博物館)
 Formation of Japanese culture from the Paleolithic period to the end of early modern period is exhibited.
