

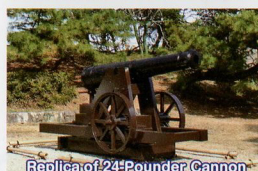

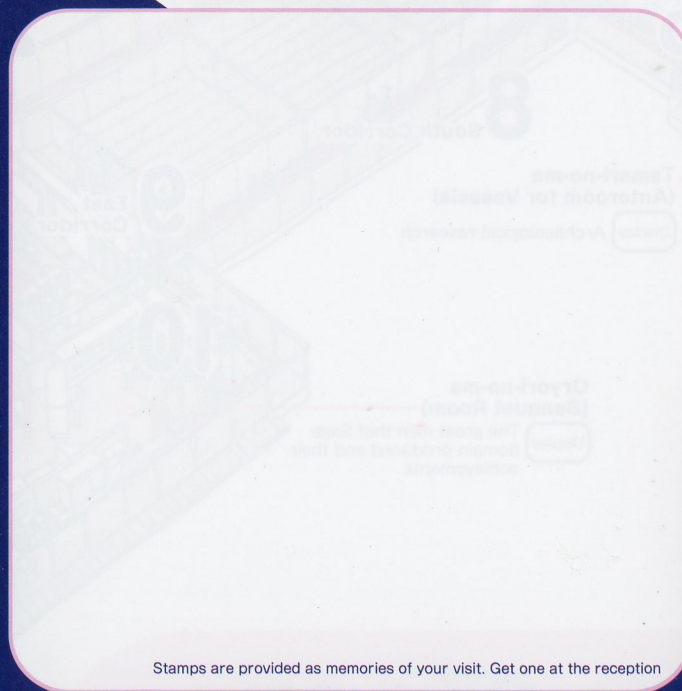

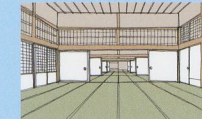

"Sotogoshoin".



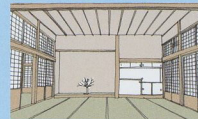
The spacious Hall has 320 tatami mats laid in its flooring

North Corridor.

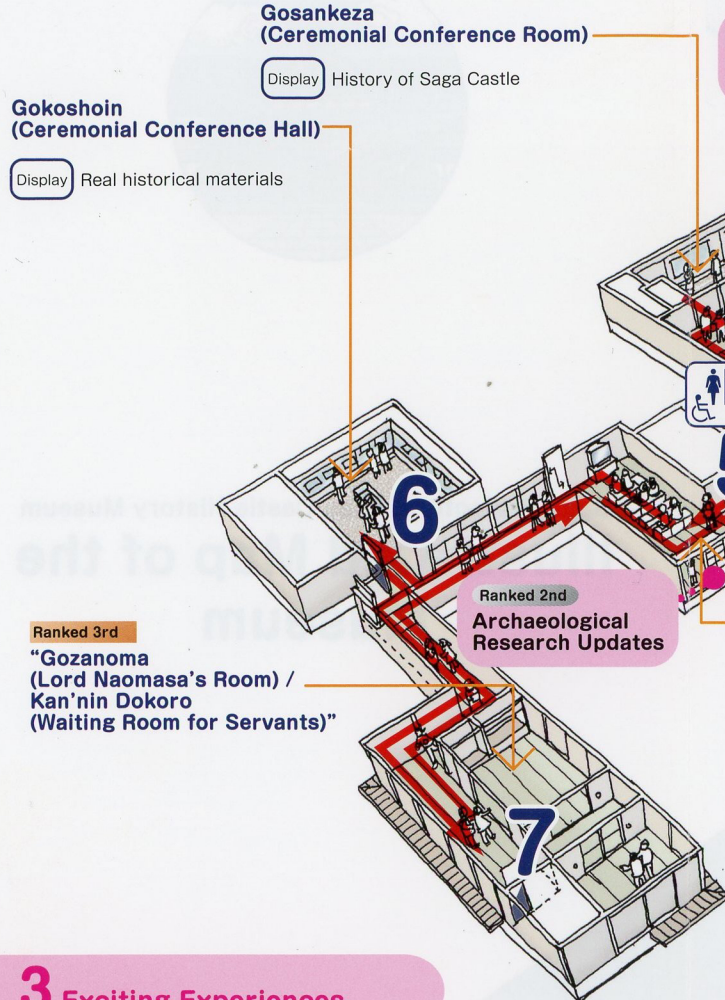


The corridor is 45 meters long.
