

This hot spring is said to be found as waterfowls were bathing there. You can enjoy soaking in it for a long time, as the water temperature is not high.




Their specialty is processed persimmons such as Hoshigaki (dried persimmon) from the Matsu-ume area.

Kyushu Saga International Airport

Shokaikyo Bridge

A cycling road with a total length of approx. 5km! Feel refreshed by cycling under the trees


A world heritage Mietsu Naval Dock

Access from Saga Airport to Saga City

Limousine Bus

The bus service is available in responce to the arrival and departure times of flights at Kyushu-SAGA International Airport(No reservation is required). For example, you can get on it from Saga Station to the airport with JPY600 fare, in 30 minutes approximately. Moreover, the wi-fi service is available for free in the bus.



Rental Car

There is a rental car service counter on the 1st floor of the Kyushu Saga International Airport Terminal. Fare: From 1,000 yen for 2 passengers or more (for the first 24 hours)



General taxi


General taxi fee between Kyushu Saga International Airport and Saga Station is approx. 4,200 yen.

Saga Airport Limousine Taxi (Must book in advance)

Share taxi directly connects between the airport and the areas in Saga prefecture and the southern-west area of Fukuoka prefecture. For online reservations, please book by 4:00 pm of the previous day. For telephone reservations, please book by 5:00 pm of the previous day.

JR Kyushu (Hakata Station - Saga Station)



Highway Express Bus (Fukuoka Airport - Saga Station)

When taking the highway express bus, it will be easier to get on and off the bus if you use an IC card (nimoca). You can pay the fare by simply placing the card on the reader equipped in the bus. This card can be purchased at the Saga Station Bus Center.

Nishitetsu Bus | Fukuoka Airport ⇄ Saga Station Bus Center

Fares: 1,230 yen for one way (2,210 yen for a round trip)
[Platform] No.3 on the 1st floor of the International Terminal

"Wakakusu" Bus

Fares: 1,030 yen for one way (1,850 yen for a round trip) — [Platform] No.4 on the 3rd floor of the Solaria Terminal Bldg.

Access from Saga Station to the directions of Fuji / Mitsuse

Buses bound for Furuyu - Hokuzan direction operate 1-2 times per hour from Saga Station Bus Center. 16 buses per day on weekdays / 8 buses per day on Saturday, Sunday, and National Holidays are currently available (approx. 1,000 yen). Buses bound for Mitsuse direction operate every 2 hours. 7 buses per day on weekdays / 5 buses per day on Saturday / 4 buses per day on Sunday and National Holidays are currently available (approx. 1,500 yen).
